### Clear Path for Veterans Warrior Arts Program

Clear Path art programming encourages Veterans and the community to learn and share life experiences through artistic expression. We offer quality instruction in a wide range of mediums for crafters, hobbyists and fine artists with beginner through advanced skill levels. Our programs allow participants to find their voice and confidently connect with others in an accepting and understanding class setting.

We are interested in multidisciplinary programming in any artistic field or medium. We seek instructors who demonstrate excellence in their craft and who possess a strong ability to teach. We demand that our instructors be compassionate, encouraging, inclusive and positive.

Our class offerings fall into three categories:

#### Community Classes

- Hosted by volunteer military and non-military members of the community
- Volunteers operate independently in marketing, student recruitment and selecting dates for meeting times
- Volunteers secure all materials needed for class
- Class description and date will be listed on Clear Path website and shared season flyer

#### Clear Path Workshops

- Hosted by military and non-military instructors who are paid a set teacher's fee
- Work with art program manager in marketing, student recruitment and selecting dates for meeting times
- Instructors and art program manager secure materials needed for class
- Class description and date will be listed on Clear Path website and shared season flyer, additional efforts implemented as needed

#### Professional Artist Series

- Hosted by professional artists who are paid through grant funding
- Artists participate in the granting process to shape the vision and scope of the class or series, and provide all information and materials demanded by the application
- Work with art program manager in marketing, student recruitment and selecting dates for meeting times
- Instructors and art program manager secure materials needed for class
- Class description and date will be listed on Clear Path website and shared season flyer, additional efforts implemented as needed
